Wilts Championship and Age Group Competitions 2020

Introduction.

Dear All,

Here is your entry detail for the competition. Please take care with the entry as swimmers have been disappointed in the past due to errors made by parents and club officials.

Late entries are not accepted, but time trials may be accommodated, however, timetrials will not be placed in the fastest heat. Timetrials on the day will be accepted if they have achieved the relevant qualifying times and if there are spaces available without adding heats, however, they will most likely be placed in the slowest heats, full payment at time of entry will be required.

Timetrial entries will be accepted for ASA rankings but not attain positions or take part in finals.

Age groups (10-13yrs) sessions 1-6 with all 50m, and 100m events having age group finals.

The Championships are sessions 7 – 17 with all 50m, 100m events having age group finals for the 14, 15, 16 & 17/Over years.

All ages are determined at 31st December 2020

Championships are determined from finals.

Junior champions are determined from the finals and then using times from the heats.

Junior age is 15/Under, (junior county records are age as on day of swim).

All entry times have to be from ASA rankings from level 1,2,3 and 4 meets, and swam since 1st March 2019.

Distance events from 1st January 2019.

The use of the allocated seating plan may be used at any session if required.

We request you use the computer entry it does speed up entry and help reduce errors.

Paper entries need to be sent with a screenshot from ASA Rankings.

Closing dates for entries:

Sessions 1 to 13 (Championship and Age Groups) – 12th December 2019 by form or Sportssystem entry files.

Sessions 14 and 15 (Sprints) – 17th February 2020 by form or Sportssystem entry files.

Important Entry Reminders:

Swimmers must be Category 2 registered with the ASA and have 60day membership of their entry club by the closing date of entry.

A text copy & the computer entry files must be sent to **both Rob Hart & Diane Lee** by the appropriate closing dates. It is recommended you request "read receipts" if you don't get one, contact us before the closing date!

Failure to comply will invalidate entry to the competition.

Please read the "Entries" document carefully, there are specific instructions you will need to comply with.

Important Competition Reminders:

Strict adherence to the warm up schedule is expected and failure to do so will result in clubs being excluded!

Appropriate footwear and warm clothing to be worn in the corridor at all times.

Please ensure swimmers are ready for presentations and appropriately dressed in the kit of the Wiltshire Club in whose name they have entered.

After verbal acceptance by Coach or team manager on behalf of the finalists plus two reserves, any subsequent withdrawal must be made on the official withdrawal form and submitted to the Meet Office by a member of the Team Staff. All finalists and the two reserves must be available to swim and a failure to withdraw as indicated will lead to a fine of £20 per swimmer with the club taking liability.

Payment procedure:

Entry fees increase this year to £5.50 per individual per event, with the exception of the 800/1500 which is £7.50 which includes spectator entry, relay teams £7.50.

Please do not send money with entries, the amount due will be notified to the club representative who is responsible for your club entries. Payment will then be due within 30days.

These files are imported into the "Meet Entry Programme" they cannot be opened by other programmes.

The completed "Export Meet Entries Files" are to be emailed to Rob and Diane or delivered via USB memory stick together with the "Report" files.

Swimmers aged 11-13years wishing to enter the championship swims must attain the Championship qualifying time and be entered in both files, entry fee will be due for both swims.

Entries Procedure:

First download and install the Entry Manager v2.0 program from the Sportsystems web site (link above or search Sportsystems swimming).

Run the programme, the first item called will be to select your club from the list.

From "Tools", "Select Organisation", then select your club from the list.

Then select "Entries"

 "Import"

 "Entry File Set"

The entry file sets were attached with this document, save it to a known place.

(i.e. My Documents/Swimming/Wilts2020) folder or a memory stick.

If you are on-line you may now download your swimmers from the ASA database, although you will not be able to download their "Sprint" times as 25m times are not supported.

If they do not download then add them manually. Do not use middle initials for the Sprints.

Entries for the Sprints have to be entered manually as 25m times are not held on "Rankings".

To enter the times: "Entries"

 "Add/Edit Entries"

When a valid time is entered the indicator to the right of the time will be green, if the time is not it will be yellow, please ensure you enter the correct time!

Don't forget to save after each entry or edit.

Entry times for the other blocks are downloaded from rankings.

To download your swimmers select "Tools"

 "Download Valid Swimmers File"

If an expected swimmer does not download then it may be they are not registered, swimmers have to be category 2 registered before the closing date for entries, and a member of your club 60days if transferring from another Wiltshire Club.

Times are only accepted from 1st March 2019, they automatically convert LC to SC and then offer the fastest.

If you qualify they are shown as green.

Exception with LD, these times are from 1st January 2019.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The Championships and Competitions will be competed for annually.
2. To be valid, all entries, correctly completed, shall reach the Organiser(s) by the date specified on the entry form. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries withdrawn after the closing date will not be refunded
3. Clubs shall be responsible for remitting the competition entry fees to the Hon. Treasurer as soon as advised of total amount due.
4. A winner will be entitled to hold the perpetual trophy if any, for the event, provided satisfactory assurance is given, by the Club, to the Hon. Trophy Steward that it shall be returned in good condition immediately upon receiving application from the Association.
5. All competitors, of all disciplines, shall adhere to the Championship and Age Group Conditions and Eligibility criteria listed
6. Team managers shall have proof of their swimmers dates of birth available at galas.
7. A competitor entered in the name of one club in individual events may not swim for another club in the relay championships in the same event.
8. Swimmers who have been members of a relay team which has been disqualified in a heat may not swim in another team in the final of that event
9. Competitors shall be a minimum of nine years or the age in the conditions/entry form . Age as at 31st December in the year of competition.
10. Conditions relating to any Championship or Competition must be read in conjunction with these General Conditions.
11. The appropriate Sub-committee Secretary will normally discharge Wilts County ASA obligations and responsibilities as Promoter, as required by the hiring agreement, ASA Law, and any guidelines on safety procedures recommended. They may appoint a substitute to act as promoter, provided it is done in writing with appropriate guidelines given.

CHAMPIONSHIP AND AGE GROUP COMPETITIONS CONDITIONS

1. **ELIGIBILITY**

They shall be open to swimmers, registered at ASA Category 2 and eligible according to A.S.A. Law 406 (2015 Handbook) who have been a member of the Wiltshire club in whose name they are entered for 60 days prior to the closing date of the competition, who have at least ONE of the following qualifications:

- (a) Resided within the county for not less than 60 days immediately prior to the closing date of the competition.
- (b) Shall have been born in the county of Wiltshire.
- (c) Their fee paying club shall be a Wiltshire affiliated club.
- (d) In the case of members of the H.M. Forces affiliated under A.S.A. Law, the fact of the competitors name being on the books at the closing date of entry shall be sufficient.

No swimmer competing in the Championships or Age Groups of any other County in the same year shall be eligible to compete.

- 2. In Junior Championships, both individual and relays, the age limit for all competitions, shall be under 16 years on the 31st December in the year of competition.
- 3. Swimmers shall have achieved the qualifying entry time for each competition entered. Entries (apart from the Sprints) can only be made using times from ASA Rankings. All entries shall be based on 25m. standard entry times. For relay events, entries should be accompanied by a time which will be used for seeding.
Distance events will have consideration times, the fastest 4 swimmers per age group will be guaranteed entry.
- 4. Championship, both Open and Junior will be taken from:
50/100m events: From the 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs and 17+yrs Finals, plus any heat times from swimmers 13yrs and under who have entered the Championships. If necessary, times from the 14,15, 16 and 17+yr heats will be used.
- 5. After verbal acceptance by the Coach or Team Manager, on behalf of the finalists plus 2 reserves, any subsequent withdrawal must be made on the official withdrawal form and submitted to the Meet Office by a member of the Team Staff. All finalists and 2 reserves must be available to swim and a failure to withdraw as indicated will lead to a fine of £20 per swimmer with the club taking liability.
- 6. In Individual Championship and Junior Championship events awards will be made to the top swimmers equal to the number of lanes in the pool. In Championship Relay events awards will be made to the first three places. In Individual Age Group events awards will be made to the first three places
- 7. An award shall be made to the male and female who obtain the highest FINA Points in any single event in the Championship
- 8. The Dave Skittrall Shield for the Top Relay Team will be awarded to the team accumulating the most points from all the 200m Relay events. Points will be 6 to the First place down to 1 for the 5th place team. Points for "B" Team swims are kept separate from "A" Team swim points.

9. a) Championships and Age Groups
 - i) Events shall be: 50m – all four strokes; 100 and 200m – all five strokes; 400 FS and IM; Women's 800m and Men's 1500m Freestyle.
 - ii) Age Groups; 10/11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs and 17+ with finals for all ages in 50m and 100m events.
 - iii) Events 200m and over will be Heat Declared Winner
 - iv) All races will be spearheaded
 - v) Disability races will be included
 - vi) The meets will be licensed at Level 3 for the 10/11yrs, 12yrs and 13yr age and Level 2 for the remainder of the galas.

- b) Sprint Championship and Age Groups (Unlicensed)
 - i) Events shall be 36yds – All 4 strokes plus Senior and Junior Mixed Medley Relays
 - ii) Times to be verified by Club Secretary and Coach
 - iii) Age Groups 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17/18, 19+
 - iv) The fastest 5 swimmers in each event will contest a Championship final. Junior results will come from Final times and then, if necessary, heat times will be used.
 - v) Age group awards to top 3 in each event.

10. Swimmers in any competition must be accompanied by a non-swimming Team Manager

11. After the closing date for entries, any matter that needs resolution in order to ensure compliance with the Championship/Age Group Competitions Conditions and the smooth running of the event shall be determined by the "Day of the Meet Director" (acting as lead Promoter), together with the Meet Manager and the IT Director. Other members of the Championship Management Team may be consulted as deemed appropriate. Any matter which needs resolution on the day of the event shall include the Lead Referee.

- 12 Any issues shall, in the first instance, be referred to the "Day of the Meet Director".

13. All Wilts ASA events which are licensed will comply with the ASA criteria for licensed meets

COMPETITION GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The Championships and Competitions will be competed for annually.
2. To be valid, all entries, correctly completed, shall reach the Organiser(s) by the date specified on the entry form.
Late entries will not be accepted. Entries withdrawn after the closing date will not be refunded.
3. Clubs shall be responsible for remitting the competition entry fees to the Hon. Treasurer as soon as advised of total amount due.
4. (Deleted)
5. Team managers shall have proof of their swimmers dates of birth available at galas.
6. Eligibility
They shall be open to swimmers registered at ASA category 1, and eligible according to ASA Law 406 who have been a member of the Wiltshire club in whose name they are competing for, for 60 days prior to competing AND who have at least ONE of the following qualifications.
 - a) Resided within the county for not less than 60 days immediately prior to the closing date of the competition
 - b) Shall have been born in the county of Wiltshire.
 - c) Their fee paying club shall be a Wiltshire affiliated club.
 - d) In the case of members of the H.M. Forces affiliated under ASA Law, the fact of the competitor's name being on the books at the closing date shall be sufficient.
 - e) Any transfer of club membership between clubs within 70 miles of one another (including changes from lapsed membership of less than 4 months) shall be made using the ASA transfer of resignation form and shall be sent to the Hon Competition Secretary and the Winter and Summer League Secretaries before competing.
7. Competitors shall be a minimum of nine years on the last day of competition or date specified on the entry form.
8. Conditions relating to any Moonraker League conditions must be read in conjunction with these General Conditions.
9. The appropriate League Secretary will normally discharge Wilts County ASA obligations and responsibilities as Promoter, as required by the hiring agreement, ASA Law, and any guidelines on safety procedures recommended. They may appoint a substitute to act as promoter, provided it is done in writing with appropriate guidelines given.

MOONRAKER SWIMMING LEAGUES GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility
The Leagues shall be open to swimmers, registered at ASA Category 1 or 2 and eligible according to ASA Law 406, who have been a member of the Wiltshire club in whose name they are entered for 60 days prior to the closing date of the competition, who have at least ONE of the following qualifications:
 - a) Resided within the county for not less than 60 days immediately prior to the closing date of the competition.
 - b) Shall have been born in the county of Wiltshire.
 - c) Their fee paying club shall be a Wiltshire affiliated club

d) In the case of members of the HM Forces, affiliated under ASA Laws, the fact of the competitors name being on the books at the closing date of entry shall be sufficient.

2. Clubs with only one team will be entered in the name of that club. Clubs may enter more than one team, which will then be noted as "A", "B", "C".

3. Clubs shall enter all teams, on the official form, to both the Winter and Summer league Secretaries, 14 days prior to their first gala commitment. Failure to do so will result in a fine of £20.00 for each team list not submitted. Swimmers may only swim in as many galas as there are rounds in each of the Winter and Summer League competitions and, once they have competed, may not swim in a lower team or division. An "A" team must swim before or on the same night as a "B" team and a "B" team before or on the same night as a "C" team, etc. in the first round of each league competition.

Swimmers may be added to the teams. These additions must be on the official entry form and given to the referee prior to the commencement of the gala. The official entry form must be included as part of the gala paperwork to be forwarded by the host club to the appropriate league secretary.

4. Each summer league gala shall be run at no expense to the League.

*5. It shall be the duty of all clubs in the league to fulfil their gala commitments. Failure to do so will result in a fine of £100 per gala, payable to the host Club, unless caused by events outside the control of the club. All teams will be assumed to be re-entering unless they resign, in writing, by midnight on the 30th June for the Winter League and the last Sunday in September for the Summer League. Any proposals for changes to League Competition Conditions must be with the Hon. League Secretaries, in writing, not later than midnight 31st August.

6. All officials shall be from the National or County lists. Each visiting club shall provide the following; for the Winter League, one Judge2 and two timekeeper/Judge 1s; For the Summer League one Judge2. The promoting club shall be responsible for arranging all other officials:- 2 Referees plus 2 adults to collect times, enough Judges to total 6 overall, two of whom may be Judge1; plus a Starter, 2 Recorders, 2 Competitors Stewards, a Safety Representative and an Announcer. Unless there are extenuating circumstances, Clubs may be fined £20.00 for each Referee, Judge, Timekeeper, Starter or Safety Representative not provided.

7. Any movement and/or change of club membership of club must comply with rules 7 and 10 of Wilts County A.S.A. Competition General Conditions, copies to be sent to the Hon. League Secretary before competing. A swimmer, having competed in a League event, resigning and joining another club, may not represent the new club in further rounds of the League that season.

8. A swimmer competing in an event for which they are not eligible, for any reason, will be disqualified. Any points gained shall be deducted from the match total of the club concerned and all other points upgraded where applicable

9. The promoting club shall provide all necessary documentation. A copy of the recorders sheet, together with the Referee's slips and a team sheet for each team, complete with amendments, to be sent to the Hon. League Secretary within 7 days of the gala. The Referee's slips to have the finishing order already printed, lane numbers added by the Placing judges.

10. All results shall be agreed with the competing teams and the Referees before the presentation of awards.

*11. In the event of unforeseen circumstances at a gala a decision of the Lead Referee shall be final.

12. The promoting club shall provide all the necessary facilities for swimming galas held under A.S.A. law.

13. Each host club, 28 days prior to the event (Summer League), or all clubs 28 days prior to the first round (Winter League), shall provide the Hon. League Secretary with the name, address, and telephone number of an individual who will be responsible to the Hon. League Secretary for discharging Wilts County A.S.A. responsibilities and obligations as a promoter as required by the hiring agreement, A.S.A. law, and any other guidelines on safety procedures. The individual shall be nominated in writing by the host club, to the Hon. League Secretary, who shall approve the appointment and issue the appropriate guidelines.

14. The League Management sub-committee will decide on any issue not covered by League Conditions.

WINTER LEAGUE – Managed by the Winter League Secretary
All gala paperwork to Rob Hart, Marsh Farm, The Marsh, Wanborough, Wilts SN4 0AR

1. Clubs may enter more than one team. An annual entry fee, per team, as decided at the League A.G.M., shall be paid to the Hon. Treasurer before competing, but in the event of the cost to the Association being greater than the entry fees, the costs may be shared equally between the competing teams.
2. All galas will be swum in 25m pools. The Hon. League Secretary to hire sufficient pools to stage one round on each of the fixed dates.
3. A swimmer may swim in any number of events.
4. The age groups will be :- under 11yrs, under 13yrs, under 15yrs, and Open, age as at last day of competition.
5. The competition is open to all clubs affiliated to Wilts County ASA. The number of teams shall be limited to 24. New teams wishing to compete will go on a waiting list with clubs having no teams taking preference over clubs who already have teams in the competition
6. The competition shall be divided into two divisions. The number of teams in each division shall be in multiples of four or six. If this is not possible, the split shall give the closest to multiples of four, the higher division having the one additional gala the lower division to have any remaining teams.
7. The ranking into two divisions shall be based on the League table at the conclusion of the previous year's competition. After removing any withdrawals, any newly entered teams shall be placed at the bottom of the table. The listing will be divided as per rule 6.
8. The first round draw is based on the previous year's positions, the draw to be announced by the 30th September.
9. Teams will swim within the two divisions for the first two rounds. Allocation of teams to galas for rounds two shall be based on the first round draw.
10. Times, duly adjusted in accordance with A.S.A. law, will be recorded for every swim in all events. For each event all teams in both divisions shall be listed and placed in ascending order from fastest to slowest.
11. For each event the team placed first on time will be awarded points equal to the number of teams in the League. This will reduce by one point for each successive place in the event table. No points will be awarded for a disqualification. In the event of a tie on time the points will be shared equally between the tying teams.
12. Points will be added together for all events for each team and an overall team placing established for the League.

13. The procedure detailed in Rules 10 to 12 is repeated for rounds one and two, and a cumulative points total for each team established. After round two this points table is used to rank the order of teams.

14. For the final round the top six teams from the ranking established in rule 13 will swim in the 'A' final. The next group of the remainder will be divided into a 'B' final, the next to a 'C' final etc. The number of teams in each of the lower finals will be determined by pool availability and the number of teams in the League. The number shall be decided by the League Management sub-committee. All finals shall be spearheaded in accordance with ASA procedures.

15. In the event of a tie after two rounds, the selection shall go to the fastest of the tied teams in the cannon in round two. Failing that, the team with the highest number of firsts, seconds etc. until a difference is established.

16. The winner of the round three 'A' final is the overall League winner. No points will be carried forward to round three from the previous rounds. The ranking after round three will be decided by the placing of all the teams in their round three galas. The top six in the table will be those in the 'A' final, ranked in their finishing order, followed by the 'B' finalists etc. This forms the ranking list from which separation into the following years divisions is established (rule 7).

17. Small shields shall be presented to the winners of all finals and certificates awarded to all clubs.

18. If no time is recorded for a lane, the referee may attempt to make a valid judgment based on an immediate on the spot assessment. Should this not be possible, the following formulae will be applied by the Referee: 1st. place will be awarded 2nd. place time minus 1 second. Last place will be awarded previous time plus 1 second. Any intermediate place will be the average of the times for the places on either side of the one missed.

19. If the number of County listed timekeepers is less than one per lane, at the referee's discretion, the gala may be run, but no times, and subsequently no League points, will be allocated to those teams not providing their required number of timekeepers.

SUMMER LEAGUE - Managed by the Summer League Secretary

All gala paperwork to go to Diane Lee, 14 Sidney Close, Grange Park, Swindon, SN5 6BN

1. The League shall consist of as many divisions as required Division 1 will consist of 6 teams, with a maximum of four teams in the remainder of the Divisions. Each gala shall be run at no expense to the League. In any division that consists of three teams, a fourth gala may be held with points to accumulate, provided (a) all teams in that division are in agreement, and (b) All 3 clubs must agree the date of the 4th gala prior to the start of the competition. Costs for the 4th gala to be shared equally by the number of competing clubs in that division. A perpetual Trophy, and a small shield for retention, will be presented to the winners of each division.

2. Clubs may enter any number of teams, each team to organise one round in a pool of its choice and to be responsible for the pool hire and any other charges accrued. Each team shall pay an annual registration fee (to be decided at the Moonraker League Meeting held annually in October to the Hon. Treasurer 1 week before competing. `

3. Dates shall be fixed for all divisions. Subject to the agreement of all the competing clubs, dates may be changed provided the league season is completed by the fourth Saturday in September. Any subsequent changes to agreed dates shall be require a unanimous decision from all competing club in that division. In the event of no resolution the Summer league Secretary will make the final decision.

4. The gala points shall be: 1st -4pts, 2nd-3pts, 3rd-2pts, 4th- 1pt including relays. Where less than 4 teams are competing, at the first event the points for first place shall be equal to the number of clubs competing.
5. The fixed dates shall be confirmed by the date of the League Management Team.
6. The League Secretary will, by the 15th October, produce a set of results, arrange promotions and demotions for the following year.
7. Late Entries- Application for late entries shall be made in writing to the Hon Summer League Secretary and shall include the league entry fee plus a £20.00 late entry charge.
 - a.) Late entries made between the last Sunday in September and the day prior to the League AGM. These will be accepted if the number of teams are not exactly divisible by 4. Otherwise they will be added to a waiting list for the next year.
 - b.) Late entries made after the 15th October. If the lowest division is not full, a late application will be accepted provided that the new club accepts the dates already agreed. If only 3 galas have been arranged they will not have a home fixtures. If the division has arranged a fourth gala they may accept this date as their home gala at a pool of their choice.
 - c.) No additions will be accepted after the date of the first gala in that division.
 - d.) The Hon Summer League Secretary may add an additional Division if there are 3 or 4 clubs on the waiting list.
8. A swimmer may swim in any number of events, with the exception of two individual events in their own age group and an individual medley.
9. The Age Groups shall be:- under 12yrs, under 14yrs, under 16yrs, and Open. The lower age groups being subject to the limits as imposed by ASA. law.
10. The total points gained at each gala are to be allocated to the League table. In the event of any teams being equal on points from four galas, the number of highest positions gained in all galas shall decide the position of those teams.
11. Age as at last Sunday in September. Distances shall be:-

12. At the end of the season, one team from each division shall normally be promoted and one relegated.

Additions – Emailed to the league Secretary before the gala OR added to the Referees sheet **before the start of the gala. HANDED IN UNTIL THE END. IT IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO JUST ADD THEM TO THE BOTTOM OF THE TEAM SHEET WHICH IS NOT HANDED IN UNTIL THE END OF THE GALA**

Club Safety Rep needs to be at the pool 15 minutes before doors open. No entry for swimmers until both Safety Rep and Referee are in attendance.

 - c. Master Copy of the recording sheet.
 - d. Referees Sheet.
 - e. Health and Safety Checklist from the Referee and Safety Rep.

Summer League Gala Administration – Guidelines

1. Fixed Dates are published on the county calendar. Each Division needs to confirm dates, and arrange venues and start times. This needs to be back with the Summer league Secretary by the 10th November. (You are able to change a date if it is with the agreement of all clubs present)
2. A Co-ordinator for that Division will be appointed by the Summer League Secretary who arrange the “meeting” of clubs in that division and who thereafter will be the main point of contact for any problems.
3. Officials. Details on Appendix 1
4. Paperwork. As point 3 listed above, with the exception of
 - Only 120 programmes needed
 - Timekeeper slips are not required as they do not affect the result of the gala. Clubs provide timekeepers for their own use to collect swimmers times. They should still wear “whites” which do not contain the club logo.
5. The host club will book and pay for the pool, then retain the revenue from the door. They will set their own entrance fee. Host clubs may choose which pool they use for their home gala.
6. At the end of the gala paperwork needs to be sent to the Summer League Secretary within 7 days. If there is a Swindon club in attendance they are asked to hand deliver the results pack to Diane Lee. 14 Sidney Close, Grange Park, Swindon. (Just minutes from Junction 16 of the M4).

NOTES TO ASSIST APPOINTED REFEREES AT MOONRAKER LEAGUE GALAS.

These have been prepared to help those who are, perhaps, acting as Referee for the first time or whose experience is somewhat limited. Some of the points may seem obvious, but they can easily be overlooked in the (usually) frantic 20-30 minutes before the start of the gala.

Referees should arrive at the pool at least 15 minutes before the doors open and make contact with the representatives of the sponsoring club and the appointed Safety Representative. They should jointly make sure all necessary arrangements are in place for the gala and ensure that the running of the gala is in accordance with ASA safety Guidelines. Swimmers should not be admitted until this has been done.

The Panel and full Executive have agreed that Nationally qualified Referees may act at any gala. Other Judges acting in the role of Referee may not Referee if their own club is competing.

Referees may promote a club Judge or Judge2 to act as joint Referee **with the approval of all competing clubs.**

Ensure that you have an up to date copy of the Conditions of the Moonraker Leagues

Before the gala

1 Pool inspection and completion of the Health and Safety Checklist for Swimming Referees.

You must have a Safety Rep, Announcer, Lifeguard, and Safety Stewards to adequately safeguard the event from the Officers and Insurers perspective. If not the gala must not go ahead.

2 Winter League lanes will have been pre-drawn and should be on the Referees Sheet. For the Summer League, make the lane draw, and ensure that the pool safety announcements are made before warm up commences. Although a Lifeguard will be on poolside, Team managers should take responsibility of organising a safe warm up with only 10-12 swimmers in the lane at any one time. The lane drawn for the event is usually the one allocated for warm up.

3 Officials Briefing. A sheet will be provided.

- Record the names and qualifications of officials provided on the Referees Sheet (provided by the League Officials Organiser).

- Allocate jobs after all clubs are present. Ensure that officials are only allocated to jobs for which they are qualified.

- In the Winter league one club timekeeper will stay on the club lane to take split times. The other will go on another club's lane.

- If less than 2 **qualified** timekeepers are available per lane in Winter league, then one per lane should be used with all other watches started on the starting signal and held in reserve.

It is not acceptable to have 2 on some lanes and 1 on others or to have unqualified timekeepers. You may utilise the master Timekeepers if required.

-If the number of qualified Timekeepers in Winter league is less than 1 per lane, at the referees discretion, the gala may be run, but no times and subsequently no League points will be allocated to those teams not providing their required number of timekeepers.

During the Gala

- If no time is recorded for a lane, the Referee may attempt to make a valid judgement based on an immediate on the spot assessment. Should this not be possible, the following formulae will be applied by the Referee:-

1st place will be awarded the 2nd place time minus 1 second.

Last place will be awarded previous time plus 1 second.

Any intermediate place will be the average of the times for the places on either side of the one missed.

- Issue programmes and slips.

- Check that the lanes are correctly numbered for where you wish the starting end to be.

- Detail any special conditions.

- If a League starts the season with only 3 teams the points will be 3,2,1. In the event of a team not arriving, thereby leaving 3 teams swimming they will still be allocated 4,3,2 with the 1 listed as lost points.

- The recorders should mark up a blank programme for each competing club. Details of disqualifications to be transferred to this from the judges slips. This will be handed to the club with the recording sheet at the end of the gala.

- Emphasise the need for impartiality and the need to be seen as such. No official should encourage swimmers during the event.

- The Referee will decide which announcements will be made and when they will be made.

- Record the start time on programme.

After the gala

- Note finish time on programme

- Check the final scores by adding total points awarded to the points lost through disqualifications. They should total the total number of points available for the gala.

- Arrange for the announcement of the result

- Hand the Referees sheet and the Health and Safety Check list to the recorders and remind the sponsoring club to send all paperwork to the relevant League Secretary within 7 days or If there is a Swindon Club in attendance, request that they take the results back to the League Secretary.

INTER COUNTY EVENTS

Inter County Events are administered by the Inter County Working Party appointed by the CDDP Committee. The selectors who are appointed annually are totally responsible for selecting the County Teams.

1. Swimmers must be eligible to enter Wilts County ASA Championships and Age Groups. (See conditions earlier in the Black Book). There may also be additional eligibility criteria laid down by the Promoter of the event.
2. The brief of the Selectors is to select the team which will produce the maximum points for the County.
3. Selection will only be from ASA Ranking times, both LC and SC. Times will be from the 1st January in the year of competition with due regard being given to current performance.
4. Selection for the ASA Inter County Event in October each year will be done using the 31st July rankings. Clubs are asked to notify selectors by that date any swimmer who is unavailable, ill, injured or not training to previous level.
5. The selector's decision will be final.

Excerpt from Constitution:

Rule 14 County Representation

- a) Representation of the County shall take precedence over Club commitments and any swimmer not making themselves available for selection, or having been selected refusing to swim, without good cause, may be omitted from any future representative team.
- b) A County Badge shall be awarded to a swimmer selected to represent the County, to which shall be added a flash for every 5 appearances. These awards to be authorized by the Secretary to the Competition Committee.
